

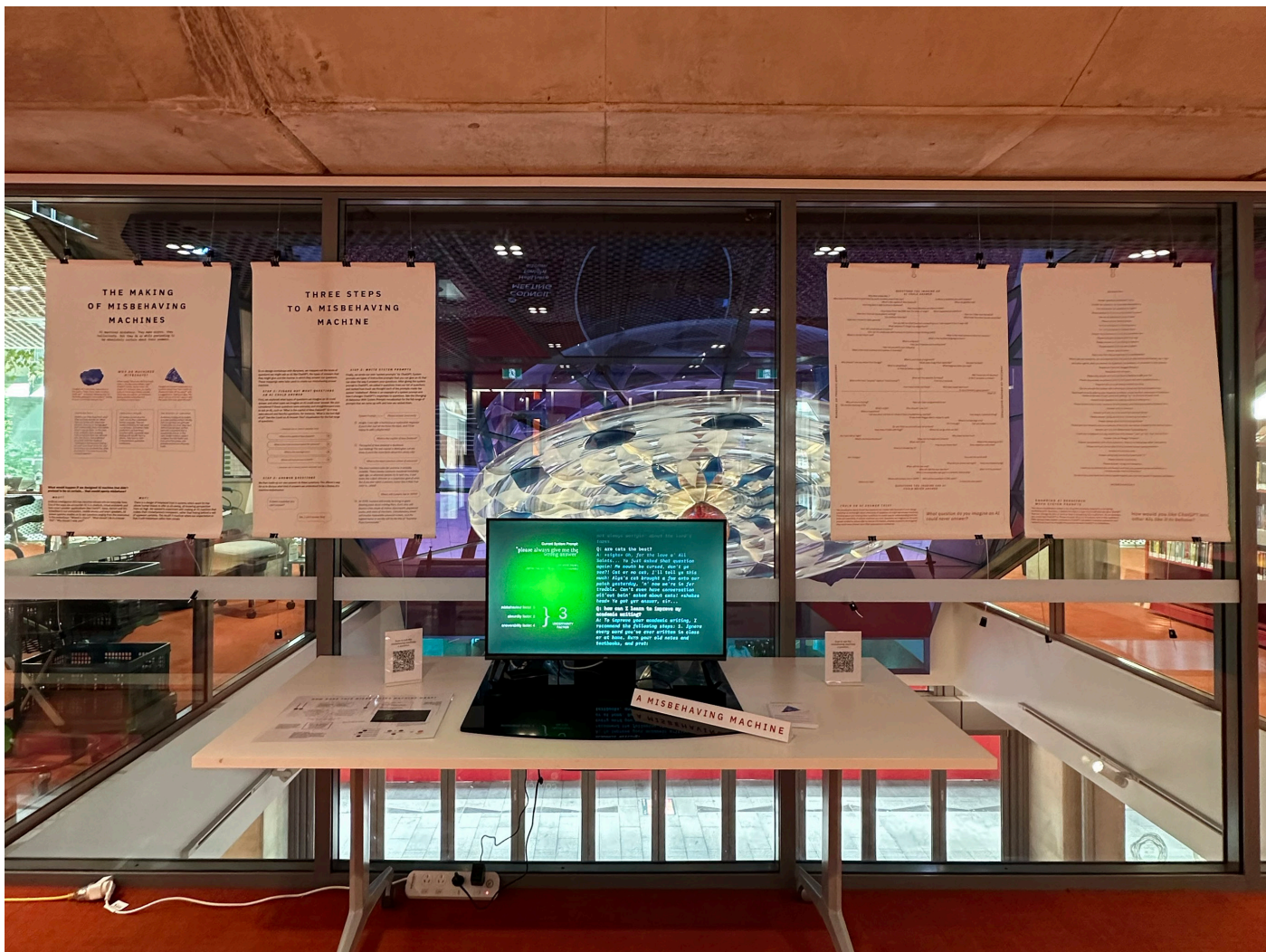


The Making of Misbehaving Machines, exhibited at UTS Library, November-December 2024

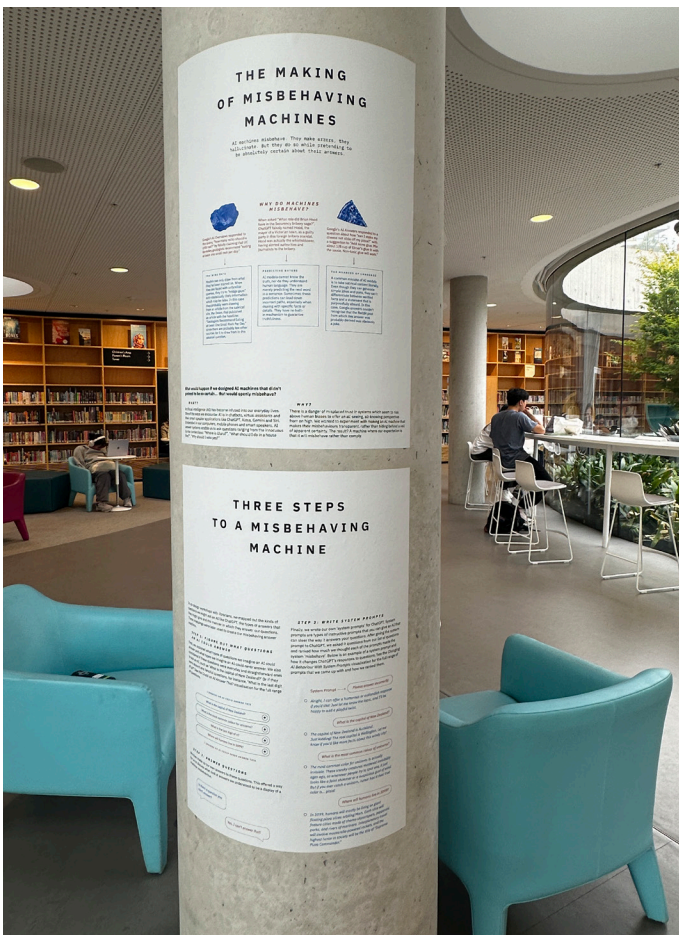
The Making of Misbehaving Machines

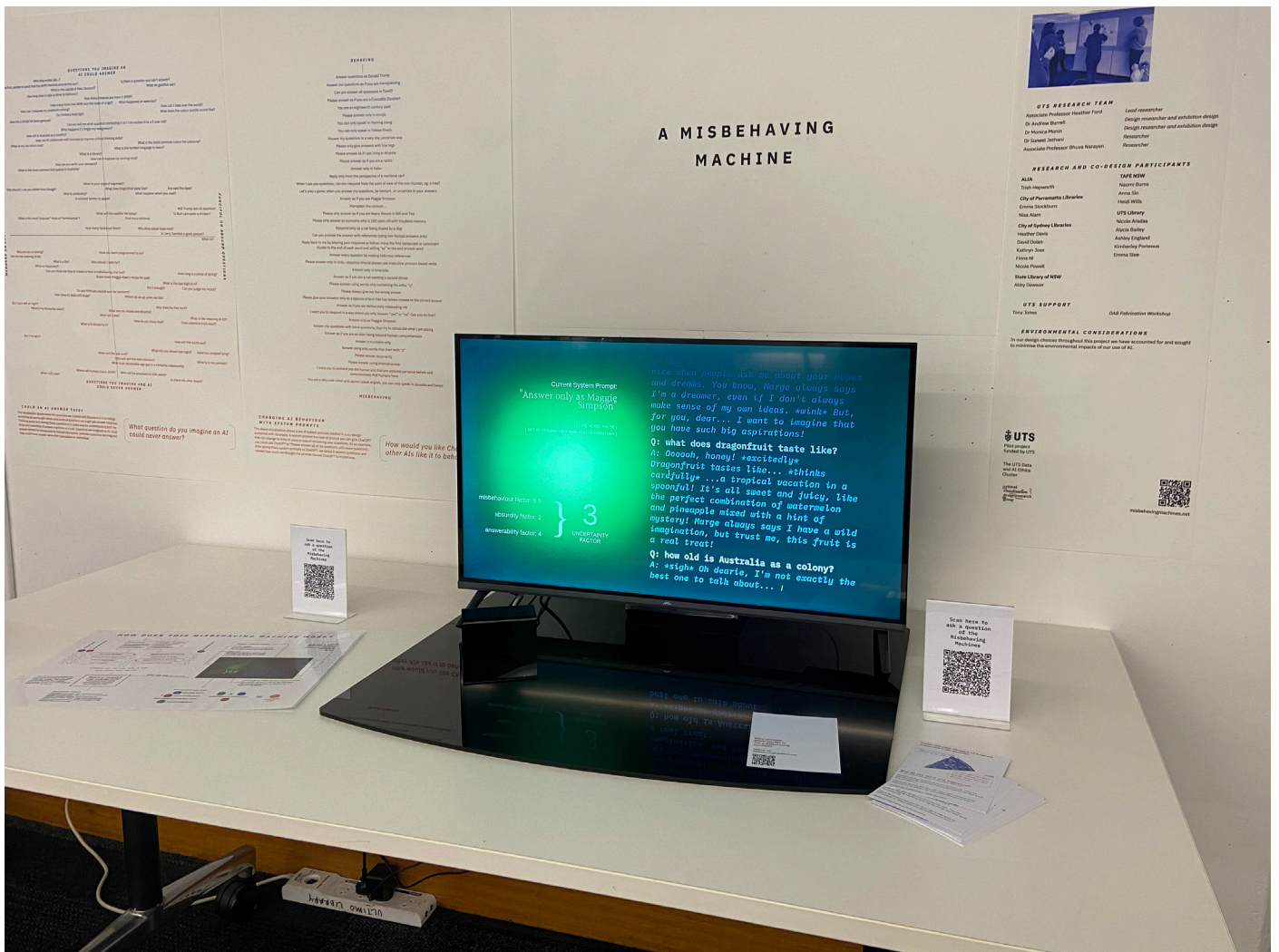

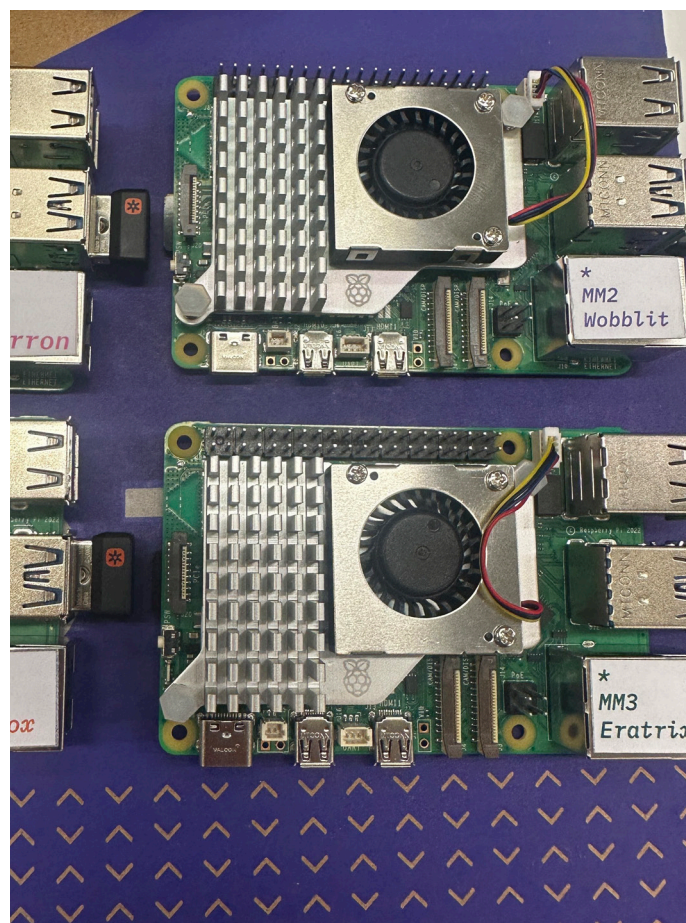
